### **Preferred Candidate Qualifications**

- Complete a minimum of 2 years of Literacy Collaborative implementation beyond the training year as a coach and trainer of teachers with your school.
- Teaching experience at both primary (K–2) and intermediate (Grade 3–6) levels.
- Success in all aspects of the Literacy Coach role (teacher of children and adults, coach, member of the literacy team) at current level as evidenced by letters from your principal (or administrator in absence of principal) and two team members/teachers. Letters should provide:
  - Evidence of interest and ability to become knowledgeable of children’s literature at the appropriate levels.
  - Evidence of the capacity to expand responsibilities and work load.
  - Evidence of strong organizational and time management skills.
- Completion of self-assessment documents.

### **School Qualifications**

- Shows evidence that the Language and Literacy Framework is implemented as designed in Literacy Collaborative classrooms at the appropriate level (primary or intermediate), documented by the Literacy Coach, Principal (or administrator in absence of principal), and University trainer.
- Showing upward trends in student achievement from data results.
- Has an established and active literacy team(s) (K–2; 3–6: K–6).
- Completes self-assessment document.
- Has shown evidence of being in good standing in relation to the Literacy Collaborative Standards.
- Completes the requirements for data collection for evaluation at the school level and submits an annual Fidelity of Implementation document to the university training site.

## School Assurances

- Provides for the Literacy Coach to teach children in the same classroom daily for the school year using Literacy Collaborative language and literacy framework for no less than 150 minutes at the appropriate grade level (K–2 or 3–5/6) to continue to develop Literacy Coaches’ skills as a teacher of children (see chart).
- Limit Literacy Coach duties exclusively to implementation of Literacy Collaborative in the school.
- Assures that the Literacy Coach will be responsible for training/coaching a limited number of primary and intermediate classroom teachers during the school year. (Because of the range of services required of the K–6 Literacy Coach, this model applies to only those schools that have 1-2 classes per grade level.)
- Assures that the Literacy Coach will provide initial training course to only one group per year, either primary or intermediate teachers.
- Assures that there is sufficient funding for the Literacy Coach to attend all required ongoing professional development, both primary and intermediate.
- Purchases **ALL MATERIALS** on required list **PRIOR TO** beginning of training (see Appendix).
